

Public Comment Policy

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1. Public comments are permitted during the “Public Comments” or “Audience Participation” portion of the Agenda.
2. The Board President may grant a request to address the Board during public participation only.
3. The Board President will ask if anyone wishes to address the Board and will determine the order in which speakers will be recognized.
4. Each speaker shall provide his or her name and address and his or her group affiliation (if any).
5. Comments should be brief and to the point.
6. An immediate response from the Board is not required.
7. Each person is allowed a maximum of three (3) minutes to speak.
8. Members of the public will not be allowed to speak a second time.
9. Any written materials presented to the Board will be included in the Library’s files rather than in the minutes.²¹
